John Kasaona Conservationist

HOW POACHERS BECAME CARETAKERS

When John Kasaona was a boy growing up in Namibia, his father took him into the bush to teach him how to take care of the family's livestock. His father said, "If you see a cheetah eating our goat, walk up to it and smack it on the backside." A cheetah is a very nervous animal. If a person confronts it, it will probably run away. John also learned how to deal with a lion by standing very still and making himself look very big. These were useful lessons for a boy who became a wildlife conservationist. As Kasaona says, "It is very important if you are in the field to know what to do and what to say to them."

Kasaona was born in 1971. At that time, Namibia had many problems. The country was at war from 1966 to 1990. Because of the fighting, many people had to leave. This caused a secondary problem – poaching. For example, poachers killed many black rhinos for their horns, which were very valuable. To make things even worse, around 1980, a terrible drought killed people, livestock, and wildlife. By 1995, there were only 20 lions left in the Kunene region in the northwest of the country where Kasaona's family lives. Many other species were also endangered.

At the same time, positive changes were taking place. A non-governmental organization, the Integrated Rural Development and Nature Conservation (IRDNC) began working in Namibia to protect wildlife. They met with village leaders to talk who would be able to work with them. They needed people who knew the bush well, and who understood how wild animals lived. The answer was surprising: work with local poachers. It seemed crazy, but it also made sense. After all, if you spend your time hunting for animals, you will know where they live and how they behave. So IRDNC hired a group of poachers, including Kasaona's own father, to help protect wildlife in Namibia.

Importantly, more land than ever is under conservation. That protected land generates money from tourism for Namibia to use in education, health care, and other important programs for its people.

John Kasaona explains, "We were successful in Namibia because we dreamed of a future that was much more than just a healthy wildlife." That someone is now a model for other African countries and nations.

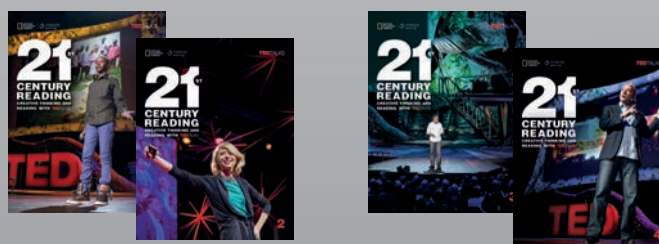

However, killing the lion, he thought, was not the best way to solve the problem. Instead, he decided to invent a solution.

A About the task

- 1 Read the information about the task type. Then look at and correct the notes a student made about the task. The student has made four mistakes.

The Sentence Completion task tests your ability to locate and record specific information from a recording. It's often used to test your understanding of a lecture or talk about a specific subject. You usually hear facts about a subject, and you may be asked to write words or numbers. Some of the information you hear is already written on the question paper, your job is to listen and complete the gaps. On the question paper, you see a set of sentences that repeat the information you hear on the recording. In each sentence, some key words are missing. You listen and write the missing words in the gaps.

Here are the basic rules for the Sentence Completion task:

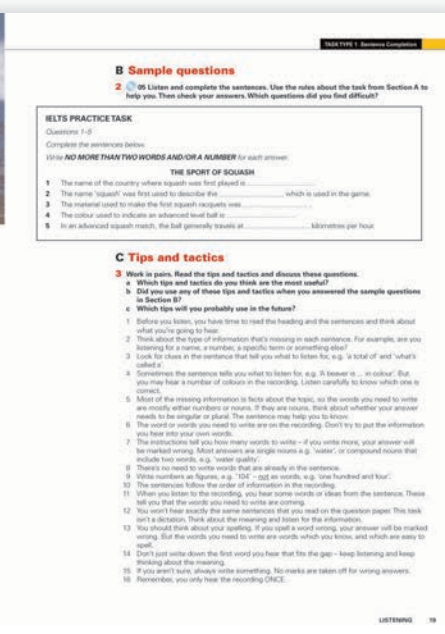
- The spoken instructions tell you how many words to write in each gap.
- The sentences come in the same order as the information in the recording.
- You don't hear the same sentences that you read on the question paper, but you do hear the same information.
- When you listen, you hear the words that you need to write.
- You write the words in the same form as you hear them on the recording (e.g. singular/plural) - you don't need to change them in any way.
- Spelling counts! The words you write must be spelled correctly.
- You hear the recording ONCE only.

It's especially important to read through the sentences before you listen, and think about the type of information you're listening for. You hear different words that could fit logically into each gap. You have to listen carefully to choose the correct information, so that the sentence reports the meaning of the recording correctly.

Sometimes you see the set of sentences presented as a summary in a piece of continuous text but the rules of the task are the same. (See IELTS Practice Task Questions 5-10 on page 211.)

Notes

1. You always hear one speaker.
2. You are listening for facts and figures.
3. You always have to write 3 words.
4. The questions are in the same order as the information on the recording.
5. You hear the continuous text ONCE on the recording.
6. You have to spell the words correctly.
7. You can listen again if you don't understand the first time.
