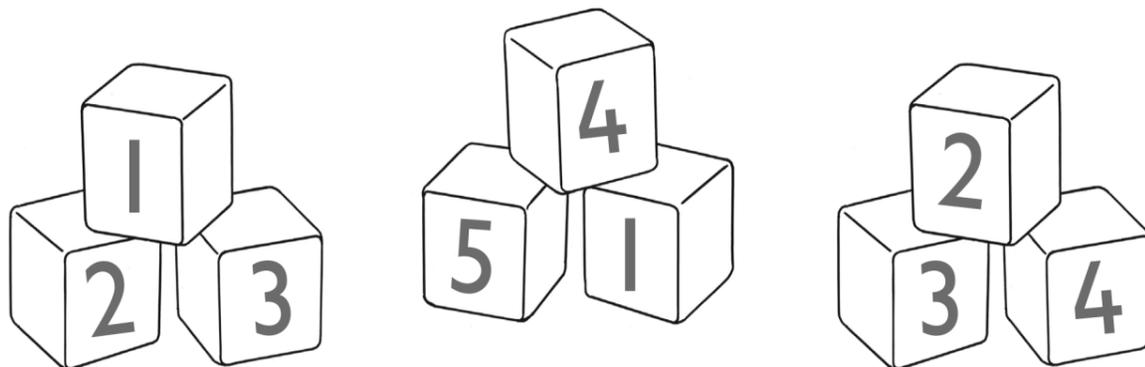
Writing Numbers to 5

- If you roll a ★, you can choose 1 2 3 4 or 5.

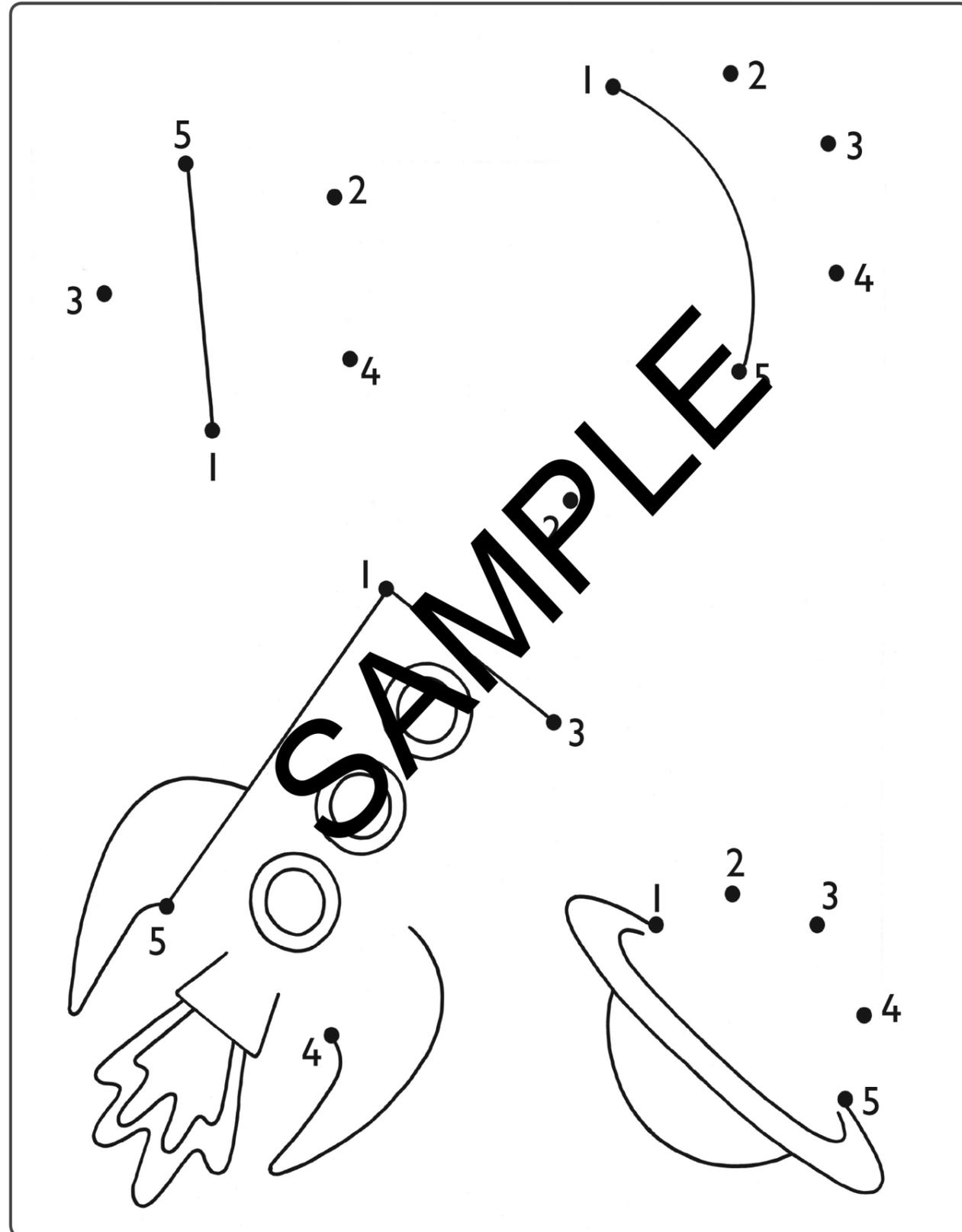
How to play:

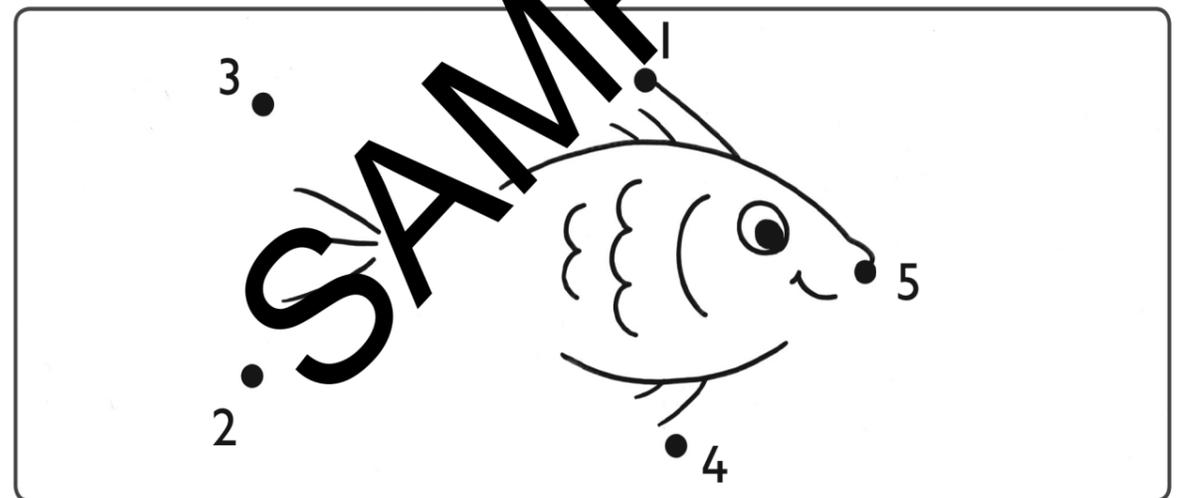
